COVID-19 Health & Safety Agreement / Commitment

COVID-19 Health & Safety Agreement

- If you develop symptoms of COVID-19 including but not limited to fever, cough, sore throat, or difficulty breathing, you will remain home and you will contact your primary physician or Telehealth Ontario for guidance on COVID-19 testing, length of self-isolation period, and eventual clearance to return to the studio.
- If you come into contact with a confirmed or suspected positive case of COVID-19, you will remain home and you will contact your primary physician or Telehealth Ontario for guidance on COVID-19 testing, length of self-isolation period, and eventual clearance to return to the studio.
- If you experience either of the aforementioned scenarios, you will notify 509 Dance/ School of CCDT staff immediately, and provide updates as needed as the situation progresses.
- I understand that if I am 12 years and older it is required to have a minimum of one COVID-19 vaccine in advance of entering 509 DANCE at 509 Parliament St and/or I will submit documentations in regards to any medical exemption from the vaccine.
- I understand that friends, parents, siblings, visitors, etc. are not permitted inside the 509 DANCE building with limited exceptions.
- I understand that I will not be permitted to enter the 509 DANCE building or participate in any in-studio dancing without a secure face mask that covers the mouth, nose, and chin.

SCCDT / CCDT COVID- 19 Health & Safety Commitments

- We have installed UV-C tubes in our return air ducts to eliminate virus and bacteria aerosols that potentially circulate via HVAC systems and we have maximized fresh air intake.
- Studios are misted with virucide and high touch surfaces are disinfected regularly.
- Our staff have all been fully vaccinated.
- Studio capacity is limited to exceed guideline distancing by 50%, using taped markings.
- We require and uphold that all dancers 12 years and older have received a minimum of one vaccine prior to entering 509 Parliament St and receive a second as soon as possible, unless they are exempt from a licensed physician.
